Wow! We can't believe the year is almost at an end. Where did the time go? We had a great time in May learning about how caterpillars turn into butterflies, how birds build nests and how snails keep our fish tank clean. The quality of writing has improved in amazing ways: we can see sentences forming, punctuation being used, words being sounded out, and spaces between those words.

We also spent time learning about 2D and 3D shapes that can be seen in our school and community environments. We used these shapes to build our own imaginative constructions.

Community helpers, such as police officers and firefighters, were introduced and we even got to meet some at the Safety Village!

June is starting off with a trip to App's Mill where we will learn about streams and what lives in them! Students must wear rain boots because we will actually be walking in the stream. Packing extra socks and shoes for the bus ride home might be a good idea. We will be outside even if it rains, so dress appropriately for the weather. As we near the end of June, we need to have all of our Take-Home Reading books returned, as well as any outstanding library books. Watch for notices that list a book price for any library books that have been lost.

If your child is in JK, you do not need to re-register him or her in SK next year. Students are automatically transferred to the next grade in the school at which they are enrolled. We will strive to keep JK students with the same teacher as they move into SK to give consistency to the kindergarten experience.

Zoo/Mohawk Park Trip and Celebration!

On June 25th we will be outside all day: at the Twin Valley Zoo in the morning and Mohawk Park in the afternoon. Please dress your child for the weather, including sunscreen and a hat. Children will need a bathing suit and towel for the splash pad in the afternoon. We will have an end of year kindergarten celebration (when SK kids will receive a 'diploma') for all three classes on Thursday, June 28th. At the conclusion of this celebration, parents are welcome to take children home with them. You will receive an official invitation with details soon.
